

## Being A Believer And Not a Doubter Sun Am 4/15/18

**2 Corinthians 5:7 (NKJV)**

**<sup>7</sup> For we walk by faith, not by sight.**

**Romans 10:17-18 (NKJV)**

**<sup>17</sup> So then faith *comes* by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.**

**<sup>18</sup> But I say, have they not heard? Yes indeed: “Their sound has gone out to all the earth, And their words to the ends of the world.”**

*Just as Israel made God jealous and angry over their worship of gods which are not real, so God was to provoke Israel to jealousy and anger by choosing a people who were not to be His chosen ones.*

**1 John 5:15-16 (NKJV)**

**<sup>15</sup> And if we know that He hears us, whatever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we have asked of Him.**

**<sup>16</sup> If anyone sees his brother sinning a sin *which does not lead to death*, he will ask, and He will give him life for those who commit sin not *leading to death*. There is sin *leading to death*. I do not say that he should pray about that.**

*God's Word is His Will.*

**2 Corinthians 5:21 (NKJV)**

**<sup>21</sup> For He made Him who knew no sin *to be sin* for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him.**

*God made Christ a sin offering that man might become righteous. The Word says I am the righteousness of God. Pit away a sin consciousness and come boldly to the throne of grace.*

**Hebrews 4:16 (NKJV)**

**<sup>16</sup> Let us therefore come boldly to the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy and find grace to help in time of need.**

*The throne from which all grace proceeds. In Israel it was the mercy seat or covering for the ark between the two cherubim. The high priest could approach this only once a year and that with the blood of atonement.*

*If he transgressed with anything he would be struck dead. His approach was with fear and trembling. The new covenant believers can come boldly to God's throne without fear and trembling, daily and any time of day. This is the freedom, confidence, and liberty of approach that they are commanded to keep until the end.*

**1 John 3:23 (NKJV)**

**<sup>23</sup> And this is His commandment: that we should believe on the name of His Son Jesus Christ and love one another, as He gave us commandment.**

**John 14:13 (NKJV)**

**<sup>13</sup> And whatever you ask in My name, that I will do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son.**

*Use the name of Jesus fearlessly and expect Jesus to perform.*

**Mark 11:25-26 (NKJV)**

**<sup>25</sup> “And whenever you stand praying, if you have anything against anyone, forgive him, that your Father in heaven may also forgive you your trespasses.**

**<sup>26</sup> But if you do not forgive, neither will your Father in heaven forgive your trespasses.”**

**Hebrews 13:15 (NKJV)**

**<sup>15</sup> Therefore by Him let us continually offer the sacrifice of praise to God, that is, the fruit of *our* lips, giving thanks to His name.**

*By Christ let us offer the sacrifice of praise continually, the fruit of our lips giving praise to His name, and not the daily sacrifice of animals which could never take away sins.*

**1 Peter 5:6-7 (NKJV)**

**<sup>6</sup> Therefore humble yourselves under the mighty hand of God, that He may exalt you in due time,**

**<sup>7</sup> casting all your care upon Him, for He cares for you.**

*Continually confess I do not have a care.*
