Luke 19:1-10 (NKJV)

19 Then *Jesus* entered and passed through Jericho.

² Now behold, *there was* a man named **Zacchaeus** who was a chief tax collector, and he was rich.

³ And he sought to see who **Jesus** was, but could not because of the crowd, for he was of short stature.

⁴ So he ran ahead and climbed up into a sycamore tree to see **Him**, for **He** was going to pass that *way*.

⁵ And when **Jesus** came to the place, **He** looked up and saw him, and said to him, “**Zacchaeus**, make haste and come down, for today I must stay at your house.”

⁶ So he made haste and came down, and received **Him** joyfully.

⁷ But when they saw *it*, they all complained, saying, “**He** has gone to be a guest with a man who is a sinner.”

⁸ Then **Zacchaeus** stood and said to the **Lord**, “**Look, Lord**, I give half of my goods to the poor; and if I have taken anything from anyone by false accusation, I restore fourfold.”

⁹ And **Jesus** said to him, “Today salvation has come to this house, because he also is a son of **Abraham**;

¹⁰ for the **Son of Man** has come to seek and to save that which was lost.”

³⁷ Then **He** said to **His** disciples, “The harvest is [indeed] plentiful, but the workers are few.

Jeremiah 17:7-8 (NKJV)

⁷ “**Blessed is** the man who trusts in the **LORD**, And whose hope is the **LORD**.

⁸ For he shall be like a tree planted by the waters, Which spreads out its roots by the river, And will not fear when heat comes; But its leaf will be green, And will not be anxious in the year of drought, Nor will cease from yielding fruit.

Once you harvest it's not seasonal- it's continual

Psalm 107:36-38 (NKJV)

³⁶ There He makes the hungry dwell, That they may establish a city for a dwelling place,

³⁷ And sow fields and plant vineyards, That they may yield a fruitful harvest.

³⁸ He also blesses them, and they multiply greatly; And He does not let their cattle decrease.

You've sowed- You've Planted- You reap, you pick it, you pack it.

Genesis 8:22 (NKJV)

²² "While the earth remains, Seedtime and harvest, Cold and heat, Winter and summer, And day and night Shall not cease."

Matthew 6:24-26 (NKJV)

²⁴ "No one can serve two masters; for either he will hate the one and love the other, or else he will be loyal to the one and despise the other. You cannot serve God and mammon.

²⁵ "Therefore I say to you, do not worry about your life, what you will eat or what you will drink; nor about your body, what you will put on. Is not life more than food and the body more than clothing?"

²⁶ Look at the birds of the air, for they neither sow nor reap nor gather into barns; yet your heavenly Father feeds them. Are you not of more value than they?"

⁹ Honor the LORD with your possessions, And with the first fruits of all your increase;

¹⁰ So your barns will be filled with plenty, And your vats will overflow with new wine

Luke 12:16-20 (NKJV)

¹⁶ Then He spoke a parable to them, saying: "The ground of a certain rich man yielded plentifully.

¹⁷ And he thought within himself, saying, 'What shall I do, since I have no room to store my crops?'

18 So he said, ‘I will do this: I will pull down my barns and build greater, and there I will store all my crops and my goods.

19 And I will say to my soul, “Soul, you have many goods laid up for many years; take your ease; eat, drink, *and* be merry.”

20 But God said to him, ‘Fool! This night your soul will be required of you; then whose will those things be which you have provided?’
