### Luke 19:1-10 (NKJV)

19 Then Jesus entered and passed through Jericho.

- <sup>2</sup> Now behold, *there was* a man named Zacchaeus who was a chief tax collector, and he was rich.
- <sup>3</sup> And he sought to see who Jesus was, but could not because of the crowd, for he was of short stature.
- <sup>4</sup> So he ran ahead and climbed up into a sycamore tree to see Him, for He was going to pass that *way*.
- <sup>5</sup> And when Jesus came to the place, He looked up and saw him, and said to him, "Zacchaeus, make haste and come down, for today I must stay at your house."
- <sup>6</sup> So he made haste and came down, and received Him joyfully.

- <sup>9</sup> And Jesus said to him, "Today salvation has come to this house, because he also is a son of Abraham;
- <sup>10</sup> for the Son of Man has come to seek and to save that which was lost."

<sup>37</sup> Then He said to His disciples, "The harvest is [indeed] plentiful, but the workers are few.
