### **Matthew 5:13-16**

<sup>13</sup> *“You are the salt of the earth; but if the salt loses its flavor, how shall it be seasoned? It is then good for nothing but to be thrown out and trampled underfoot by men.*

<sup>14</sup> *“You are the light of the world. A city that is set on a hill cannot be hidden.*

<sup>15</sup> *Nor do they light a lamp and put it under a basket, but on a lampstand, and it gives light to all who are in the house.*

<sup>16</sup> *Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven.*

### **Mark 9:50**

<sup>50</sup> *Salt is good, but if the salt loses its flavor, how will you season it? Have salt in yourselves, and have peace with one another.”*

### **Luke 11:33**

<sup>33</sup> *“No one, when he has lit a lamp, puts it in a secret place or under a basket, but on a lampstand, that those who come in may see the light.*

### **Luke 14:35**

<sup>35</sup> *It is neither fit for the land nor for the dunghill, but men throw it out. He who has ears to hear, let him hear!”*

**<sup>18</sup> But the path of the just *is* like the shining sun, That shines ever brighter unto the perfect day.**

**<sup>19</sup> The way of the wicked *is* like darkness; They do not know what makes them stumble.**
