

## How Can I Know God's Will For Me?

### It Is God's Will For Everyone To be Saved.

#### 2 Peter 3:9 (NKJV)

<sup>9</sup> The Lord is not slack concerning *His* promise, as some count slackness, but is longsuffering toward us, not willing that any should perish but that all should come to repentance.

#### John 3:16-17 (NKJV)

<sup>16</sup> For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life. <sup>17</sup> For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world through Him might be saved.

#### 1 John 1:9 (NKJV)

<sup>9</sup> If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us *our* sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

#### Romans 10:9-10 (NKJV)

<sup>9</sup> that if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. <sup>10</sup> For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.

**1 Timothy 2:3-4 (NKJV)**

**<sup>3</sup> For this *is* good and acceptable in the sight of God our Savior, <sup>4</sup> who desires all men to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth.**

## **We are To Study God's Word To Know His Will**

**2 Timothy 2:15 (NKJV)**

**<sup>15</sup> Be diligent to present yourself approved to God, a worker who does not need to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth.**

**James 1:5 (NKJV)**

**<sup>5</sup> If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask of God, who gives to all liberally and without reproach, and it will be given to him.**

**Romans 12:1-2 (NKJV)**

**12 I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, *which is* your reasonable service. <sup>2</sup> And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what *is* that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.**

## **We Are To Trust In God**

**Jeremiah 29:11 (NKJV)**

**<sup>11</sup> For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, says the LORD, thoughts of peace and not of evil, to give you a future and a hope.**

### Proverbs 3:5-6 (NKJV)

<sup>5</sup> Trust in the LORD with all your heart, And lean not on your own understanding;

<sup>6</sup> In all your ways acknowledge Him, And He shall direct your paths.

### Hebrews 11:1-3 (NKJV)

**11** Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen. <sup>2</sup> For by it the elders obtained a *good* testimony.

<sup>3</sup> By faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the word of God, so that the things which are seen were not made of things which are visible.

### Hebrews 11:6 (NKJV)

<sup>6</sup> But without faith *it is* impossible to please *Him*, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and *that* He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him.

### Matthew 6:10 (NKJV)

<sup>10</sup> Your kingdom come. Your will be done On earth as *it is* in heaven.

### Matthew 6:33 (NKJV)

<sup>33</sup> **But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you.**

Luke 9:23 (NKJV)

<sup>23</sup> Then He said to *them* all, **“If anyone desires to come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross daily, and follow Me.**

Job 5:8-9 (NKJV)

<sup>8</sup> “But as for me, I would seek God, And to God I would commit my cause—

<sup>9</sup> Who does great things, and unsearchable, Marvelous things without number.

## **God Desires Us To Serve In and Grow In A Local Church**

Hebrews 10:25 (NKJV)

<sup>25</sup> not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as *is* the manner of some, but exhorting *one another*, and so much the more as you see the Day approaching.

Romans 10:17 (NKJV)

<sup>17</sup> So then faith *comes* by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

2 Timothy 4:2 (NKJV)

<sup>2</sup> Preach the word! Be ready in season *and* out of season. Convince, rebuke, exhort, with all longsuffering and teaching.

Matthew 18:20 (NKJV)

<sup>20</sup> **For where two or three are gathered together in My name, I am there in the midst of them.”**

**Acts 2:42 (NKJV)**

**<sup>42</sup> And they continued steadfastly in the apostles' doctrine and fellowship, in the breaking of bread, and in prayers.**

**John 10:27 (NKJV)**

**<sup>27</sup> My sheep hear My voice, and I know them, and they follow Me.**

**2 Corinthians 5:7 (NKJV)**

**<sup>7</sup> For we walk by faith, not by sight.**

**James 4:7 (NKJV)**

**<sup>7</sup> Therefore submit to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you.**

**Joshua 1:8-9 (NKJV)**

**<sup>8</sup> This Book of the Law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate in it day and night, that you may observe to do according to all that is written in it. For then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have good success. <sup>9</sup> Have I not commanded you? Be strong and of good courage; do not be afraid, nor be dismayed, for the LORD your God *is* with you wherever you go.”**

**1 Thessalonians 5:18 (NKJV)**

**<sup>18</sup> in everything give thanks; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you.**

**Colossians 3:17 (NKJV)**

**<sup>17</sup> And whatever you do in word or deed, *do* all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through Him.**

**Philippians 4:4 (NKJV)**

**<sup>4</sup> Rejoice in the Lord always. Again I will say, rejoice!**
