Offense: The Bait Of Satan We 7/5/17

Luke 17:1-4 (NKJV)

17 Then He said to the disciples, "It is impossible that no offenses should come, but woe *to him* through whom they do come!

- ³ Take heed to yourselves. If your brother sins against you, rebuke him; and if he repents, forgive him.
- ⁴ And if he sins against you seven times in a day, and seven times in a day returns to you, saying, 'I repent,' you shall forgive him."
- 2 Timothy 2:24-26 (NKJV)
- ²⁴ And a servant of the Lord must not quarrel but be gentle to all, able to teach, patient,
- ²⁵ in humility correcting those who are in opposition, if God perhaps will grant them repentance, so that they may know the truth,
- ²⁶ and *that* they may come to their senses *and escape* the snare of the devil, having been taken captive by him to *do* his will.

Galatians 6:1-5 (NKJV)

6 Brethren, if a man is overtaken in any trespass, you who *are* spiritual restore such a one in a spirit of gentleness, considering yourself lest you also be tempted.

² It would be better for him if a millstone were hung around his neck, and he were thrown into the sea, than that he should offend one of these little ones.

² Bear one another's burdens, and so fulfill the law of Christ.

³ For if anyone thinks himself to be something, when he is nothing, he deceives himself.

⁴ But let each one examine his own work, and then he will have rejoicing in himself alone, and not in another.

⁵ For each one shall bear his own load.

¹⁹ A brother offended *is harder to win* than a strong city, And contentions *are* like the bars of a castle.

Matthew 18:15-17 (NKJV)

- ¹⁵ "Moreover if your brother sins against you, go and tell him his fault between you and him alone. If he hears you, you have gained your brother.
- ¹⁶ But if he will not hear, take with you one or two more, that 'by the mouth of two or three witnesses every word may be established.'
- ¹⁷ And if he refuses to hear them, tell *it* to the church. But if he refuses even to hear the church, let him be to you like a heathen and a tax collector.
