John 17:3 (NKJV)

³ And this is eternal life, that they may know You, the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom You have sent.

Jeremiah 29:11-13 (NKJV)

¹¹ For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, says the LORD, thoughts of peace and not of evil, to give you a future and a hope.

¹² Then you will call upon Me and go and pray to Me, and I will listen to you.

¹³ And you will seek Me and find Me, when you search for Me with all your heart.

Jeremiah 24:7 (NKJV)

⁷ Then I will give them a heart to know Me, that I *am* the LORD; and they shall be My people, and I will be their God, for they shall return to Me with their whole heart.

Psalms 19:14 (NKJV)

¹⁴ Let the words of my mouth and the meditation of my heart Be acceptable in Your sight, O LORD, my strength and my Redeemer.

Jeremiah 9:23-24 (NKJV)

²³ Thus says the LORD: "Let not the wise *man* glory in his wisdom, Let not the mighty *man* glory in his might, Nor let the rich *man* glory in his riches;

²⁴ But let him who glories glory in this, That he understands and knows Me, That I *am* the LORD, exercising lovingkindness, judgment, and righteousness in the earth. For in these I delight," says the LORD.

Isaiah 26:3 (NKJV)

³ You will keep *him* in perfect peace, Whose mind *is* stayed on You, Because he trusts in You.

Psalms 46:10 (NKJV)

⁷ He will not be afraid of evil tidings; His heart is steadfast, trusting in the LORD.

Psalms 57:7 (NKJV)

⁷ My heart is steadfast, O God, my heart is steadfast; I will sing and give praise.

Psalms 91:14-15 (NKJV)

¹⁴ "Because he has set his love upon Me, therefore I will deliver him; I will set him on high, because he has known My name.

¹⁵ He shall call upon Me, and I will answer him; I *will* be with him in trouble; I will deliver him and honor him.

Psalm 123:1-2 (NKJV)

23 Unto You I lift up my eyes, O You who dwell in the heavens.

² Behold, as the eyes of servants *look* to the hand of their masters, As the eyes of a maid to the hand of her mistress, So our eyes *look* to the LORD our God, Until He has mercy on us.

Colossians 3:1 (NKJV)

Proverbs 5:1-2 (NKJV)

Proverbs 4:25-27 (NKJV)

²⁵ Let your eyes look straight ahead, And your eyelids look right before you.

2 Samuel 11:1-4 (NKJV)
