Have you ever felt like God is mad at you? Have you ever thought this is it, after what I have just done there is no way God will ever forgive me? Have you made promise after promise to "do better"? Have you told God "this is the last time I'm doing this" only to fall back into the same sin you vowed you would never commit again?

If this is you, then I am about to give you a strange greeting: welcome to the club. As crazy as it sounds your situation is not unique to you, there are many others before you who have felt this way. Because we fall into these places of temptation and failure there is the tendency to believe God is mad at you.

I need you to know today that God is not mad at you. To prove it I want to share six reasons with you, so you can know for certain that God is not mad at you.

1. He sent his only begotten Son to die for you. John 3:16, He loves us with an everlasting love (Jeremiah 31:3).
 2. He has forgiven you of you all your sins. 1 John 1:9, God is for us, not against us (Romans 8:31).
 3. He has forgotten them. Isaiah 43:25, Acts 3:19, Ps. 103:11-12.
 4. His love never ceases, & His mercies never come to an end they are new every morning; great is your faithfulness. Lam. 3:22-23
 5. He began, & will complete the good work in you Phil. 1:6
 6. He has good plans for us. Jer. 29:11
